Procurement logistics (synergism, -determining the degree of utilisation in the context of the distribution policy) in the original dispositive structure — in addition to research/development, transformation process (optimum factor allocations [i. a. consumable resources]): I. a. increase in productivity ($P_i = x_i/b_j \rightarrow b/x = 1$ [threshold value]), including determination of batch size for the Leontief- (linear limitational — assembly line production)/substitutional production (process sourcing — TCO = Total Cost of Ownership / supply chain management), sales marketing, finance- and internal accountancy (static-/dynamic considerations).
